2016 BLACKPOOL DANCE FESTIVAL A Quick Guide for Newcomers

From Thursday, May 26 through Friday, June 3, the best dancers in the world will be gathering at an obscure seaside resort in Lancashire, England. Arguably the most prestigious dancesport competition in the world, the Blackpool Dance Festival will take over the town.

In my opinion, every lover of dance should experience this event at least once. About seven years ago, I went for the first time and have been back, every year except one. I usually try to sail over or back on the Queen Mary 2 (dancing my way there), but, this year, to save time, I am flying.

If you can afford the time, attend on all nine days, but, if you can't, you can attend just the last four nights, when the biggest events occur. I prefer another alternative: go for a long weekend, from Friday to Monday, and fly home Tuesday. This will include the best event of all - the invitational team match on Saturday night.

This year, I am flying from Philadelphia on Thursday night, arriving on Friday morning. The nearest international airport is Manchester (American Airlines has non-stop flights). A train station in the airport is easily accessible to take you to the Blackpool North train station for about £30. For three or more people, a cab is a better choice, but be sure to request one that can handle everyone and luggage. From Blackpool North, it's a very short taxi ride to anywhere in town.

The Imperial Hotel is the main hotel in the area and has dance vendors' merchandise for sale on the ground floor. (My favorite designer, Espen Salberg, has his sales center there.) A free shuttle is provided from the Imperial Hotel to Winter Gardens, where the competition is held, but it stops in the early evening when all the

WDSF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS SENIOR I 10-DANCE AND STANDARD COME TO BOSTON, USA

On October 8 and 9, two **World DanceSport Federation** world championships are coming to the USA. With the support of **USA Dance Inc.** (USAD), an organization called **American DanceSport Festival** (ADSF) will be running the Senior I Standard and Senior I 10-Dance World Championships. ADSF is focused on bringing more WDSF events, including competitions and training camps, to the USA.

The events will be held in Boston, MA at the Clark Athletic Center at the University of Massachusetts. ADSF's website (www.americandsf.org) and its Facebook page are under development; however, it can be reached at americandsf@gmail.com. On Facebook, search for "American DanceSport Festival" and look for its logo (right).




According to Ken Richards, Senior Vice President of USAD, the Senior I World Championships are not limited to two representatives per country, this year, as they have been in the past, but the attendees must be nominated by each country's National Governing Body (USAD, in the US).

USAD will provide travel stipends to its top two eligible couples in the standard event and its top eligible couple in the 10-dance event, as determined by the their placement in the equivalent events at the 2016 USAD National Championships, held a few weeks ago. It also plans to nominate other eligible championship level athletes where at least one member of the partnership is a US citizen, provided the athletes are members in good standing of USAD and have WDSF ID cards. Sounds like a great event to watch!

The Ten Commandments of Social Dancing

- 1. Thou shalt wear deodorant and brush thy teeth. Always. And 6. thou shalt ask thy friends whether thou require more deodorant or teeth-brushing than currently.
- 2. If thy friend asks if he/she requires more deodorant or breath mints, thou shalt not lie.
- 3. Thou shalt not purposely touch thy partner's bottom, breasts, or other private areas with thy hands, or touch any part of her/his body with thy tongue or mouth without her/his permission. If thou decides to do such things, thy partner may leave thy company or slap thy cheek (either one).
- 4. Thou shalt remember that dips are not necessary in every dance or with every partner. Thou shalt realize that the follower shall hold her/his own weight, and that the leader shall not force thy follower into awkward and uncomfortable positions against her/his will.
- 5. Thou shalt never give unsolicited advice during a social dance, under threat of social exile.

- 6. Thou shalt recognize that dance is a journey, not a race. More patterns at fast speeds does not a great dancer make.
- 7. Thou shalt not lift on the dance floor. Partners are not weights, and the social floor is not a gym.
- 8. Thou shalt respect the word and actions of "No." Thou shalt recognize that thy partner may decline a dance, may decline a move, or may decline thine advances and that it is thy duty to not force thy will upon them.
- 9. Do unto others as thou would do unto thyself. Thou shalt treat all dancers with respect and dignity.
- 10. Thou shalt dance at thine own level or the level of thy partner (whichever is lower). If thou wish to use more difficult moves, thou shalt seek out training. With a professional not YouTube.

vendors close. It's a comfortable walk - but not in high heels. At the end of the evening competition, taxis are readily available.

I prefer to be closer to the competition and main exhibition hall by staying at a B&B. There are many within a few blocks of Winter Gardens, but they sell out early. If you are going, it's not a bad idea to book a year in advance. Think small and oldfashioned and you won't be disappointed.

Going for a long weekend means that you will miss the big four nights at the end; however, during the Saturday night Professional Team Match, you will see the probable winners and finalists of the professional standard and Latin events.

This year, a new event has been added to Saturday night: the Senior Over 50 Ballroom Championship. I hope to see some of my friends participating in this event.



On Sunday afternoon, I usually visit the Blackpool Tower for social dancing; however, this year, it is closed on May 29 (boo hoo). Fortunately, it is open, every other day, during the Festival. Pictured above, it is within walking distance of the Winter Gardens and the surrounding B&B's. For less than £10, you can dance from 10 am to 5 pm to continuous live music. I guess I'll have to go on Saturday or Monday.

On Sunday evening, all the North American competitors are invited to a dinner at the Imperial Hotel. The event is free for competitors and restricted to sponsors of the Blackpool Project, guests of sponsors and competitors who have pre-registered. In addition to the dinner, the organizers of the Blackpool Project, Joy and Colin Hillary, provide a practice space for the North American competitors at the Imperial Hotel. In appreciation, the US/Canada Team usually prepares an entertaining skit. (I still remember the shock of seeing Arunas Bizokas in white ballet tights.) If you are going and would like to be a sponsor, contact Joy Hillary at vivadanpro@aol.com or call 954.757.5101. There is no minimum amount to be a sponsor, as far as I know, but sponsors still have to buy their dinner tickets for \$75 each.

Plan some time for shopping. During this week, Blackpool has the best offerings for dancers that I have ever seen. In addition to the vendors that set up at the Imperial Hotel, there is a huge exhibit hall in Winter Gardens. You do not need to buy a ticket to the event to visit the vendors. You can easily spend more in the exhibit hall than you did for the entire trip. Many local shops cater to the dancers, too, and I have found some of my most admired items, just walking around town. In addition to clothing, they offer dance shoes and hair and other accessories.

The first two years that I attended, I bought a season ticket with reserved seats. These must be purchased very far in advance to get reasonable seats (prior year attendees get first dibs on repurchasing/improving their seats) and reserved seats are not sold individually, in advance. Now, I buy standing room only tickets at the door. In 2016, the price is £36 for the full day (Thursday and Sunday are less). While I do not have a reserved seat, I am always able to find a seat that is better than any that was available for a season pass. Last year, I sat in the front row! I hope to see you there! If not, start planning for next year!
