Liberty Ball - A New Competition Comes to Philadelphia

If you are a dancer, do not miss a great chance to show off your skills in front of an international judging panel. If you are a spectator, make sure to be there to watch all the great dancers in action and an evening amateur show!

On October 10, Liberty Ball's co-organizers Renata Shvarts (organizer of Staten Island's *Islanders DanceSport Challenge*) and Jenny Mesh are bringing this newest USA Dance competition to Philadelphia. This competition will be the first event in Pennsylvania to feature the new teacher/student category, as well as amateur couples' events, including juvenile, junior, youth, adult and senior I, II and III events in Latin, standard, smooth, rhythm and cabaret divisions. Liberty Ball will also hold same-sex and show dance events.

Renata and Jenny are trying to give this new competition the feel of a World DanceSport Federation (WDSF) event with artistic lighting and décor, plus a judging panel that will include national, international and WDSF judges, allowing competitors to dance in front of some of the top adjudicators in the business.

All closed syllabus events will be invigilated using the current USA Dance, Inc. (USAD) list of elements and restrictions and USAD costume rules will apply. This will be a great opportunity for competitors who plan to participate in USAD national qualifying events and/or the USAD 2016 National Championships to try out their costumes and routines to ensure that they meet USA Dance rules. As a new event, participants will not accrue proficiency points.

Sponsorship and scholarships from various dance organizations and community businesses will be awarded.

Liberty Ball is already showing early signs of being the biggest junior event in southeastern Pennsylvania, with support from many of the junior studios in the tri-state area surrounding Philadelphia.

Registration has already begun and changes or additions to entries after October 1st, 2015 will be accepted at the sole discretion of the organizers.

Competitor entry fees will range from \$10 for junior single dance events to \$15 per dance for syllabus events to \$75 for championship events. Spectator all-day admission is \$25 for adults, \$10 for children 5-12 years of age and free to children under 5. Competitors will not have to pay an admission fee.

KADEL'S KORNER: Pete on Repeat

Peter Kadel, Fellow & Trainer, Imperial Society (ISTD)

Many dancers make the mistake of repeating steps in the International ballroom dances that cannot, will not or should not be repeated. Below please find the list of steps that CAN be repeated according to the ISTD syllabus, which is a much shorter list than those steps that cannot be repeated.

WALTZ - Bronze, Silver, Gold:

- Closed Changes, for practicing only
- Natural Turn, around the corner; four measures
- Reverse Turn, normal amount of turn to end DW against the LOD and followed by a Turning Whisk (not sanctioned by the ISTD); four measures
- Double Reverse Spin
- Weave from promenade position can be repeated when its third step is kept in promenade position
- Open Telemark and Wing can be repeated, but the second one will end in an awkward position in the room
- Fallaway Reverse and Slip Pivot
- Fallaway Whisk can be repeated, starting the second one in promenade position



FOXTROT - Bronze, Silver, Gold:

- Natural Turn, at the corner only
- Open Telemark and Feather Ending
- Top Spin; dance eight quicks
- Open Telemark, Open Natural, Outside Swivel, Feather Ending is repeatable
- Fallaway Reverse and Slip Pivot.
- Bounce Fallaway with Weave Ending into corner.

QUICKSTEP - Bronze, Silver, Gold:

- Natural Turn, around the corner
- Natural Pivot Turn
- Forward Lock (not good)
- Back Lock (not good)
- Double Reverse Spin.
- Fish Tail.(not good)
- Running Right Turn
- Rumba Cross

TANGO - Bronze, Silver, Gold:

- Closed Promenade
- Open Promenade
- Back Corté
- Progressive Side Step Reverse Turn
- Natural Twist Turn
- Natural Promenade Turn
- Back Open Promenade, when ended in promenade position.
- Fallaway Promenade
- Four Step Change
- Brush Tap
- The Chase
- Fallaway Reverse and Slip Pivot

Practice Dance, Socially Speaking

Why do we dance? The simple answer is because we can. Yet, to practice dance, socially speaking, allows us to more fully connect to our authentic selves and with others, too. Author and philosopher, Kimerer LaMothe PhD tells us, "Any dance tradition or technique represents movement patterns that those persons have

implies that there is pleasure in dancing for fun and that more dancing would mean more fun. It also suggests the ability to be social, while being engaged in the dancing in public.

Dances and dance parties should, therefore, be the best choice for the social dancer. Although dances may last for several hours, attendees are

Third, social dances are intended to be fun. A dance host/instructor makes a concerted effort to incorporate theme dances that create an atmosphere of playfulness and camaraderie among the attendees. Dances can also include "mixers" that allow all the attendees to meet new people. The purpose is to lower dance

found useful for connecting them to something they perceive as having value – whether tribe or tradition, pleasure or skill, community or divinity, heaven or Earth. Dance as movement is inherently relational."

Why is it, then, that group classes' students are not knocking down the doors at our practice, social, theme and formal dance events to express themselves on the dance floor?

The most common excuse for avoiding a dance event is the one that must be permanently shattered. This is the excuse that "I'm not good enough at my steps to attend an event that is comprised of hours of dancing." There are enough variations on this statement to warrant the writing of an "Excuses for Not Dancing" book!

Rather than focusing on the "can'ts" of dance, let us focus on the practice of dance. The rationale for doing so is multi-faceted. First, the majority of dance students are social dancers. The term *social dancer* immediately

not required to dance for the entire time. The pace of a dance is unstructured and leisurely, with access to other students and instructor for asking questions and testing movements.

Second, all dancers, including social dancers, benefit from more time to practice their skills. Because a dance event is several hours longer than a group class or private lesson, it is exactly what is needed for mind and body to absorb new information. Learning to dance well comes from making errors, analyzing them, and working to correct them. Dance events offer hundreds of opportunities for the trial and error/ success of the dance learning process. Typically, there are many people that attend a social dance event, which allows for frequent switching of dance partners to verify that the leader's signaling skills or a follower's response skills are more than memorized choreography between two partners.

anxiety by building up acceptance and friendliness among the dance community. This approach makes it easier to try new steps because you don't feel judged.

A practice dance, socially speaking, is just a gathering of like-minded individuals into a fun environment that is conducive to the trial-and-error learning of dance for the purpose of improving skills. So, the next time your teacher puts out a flyer for an upcoming dance event, race to grab a copy, wave it in the air and exclaim: "I'm going! Who's with me?" Trust me, that will be like music to your teacher's ears versus the automatic "I can't; I'm not good enough," reply.

Gluten Free? Not Just a Fad

Gluten is the protein portion of primarily four grains: wheat, rye, barley and, on a lesser scale, oats. From digestive distress to Alzheimer's, gluten has been implicated as at least a contributory, if not the outright, cause of every symptom and syndrome of which you can think. Why is that? And, more interestingly, why so prevalent now? After all, who ever heard of gluten, 20 years ago?

The "why" is that gluten causes inflammation in varying degrees in predisposed individuals. The degree to which it affects one determines the severity of the symptom picture. An individual's weak link will also determine what is hit first or hardest.

The "why now" requires a little historical perspective. It's believed that homus erectus, the first upright man, appeared about two million years ago. For the subsequent 1,990,000 of those years, man ate what he hunted and gathered. Then, roughly 10,000 years ago, Egyptians began to domesticate grasses, which led to pasta and bread.

Given that our current genetic makeup is thought to be about 30,000 years old, the introduction of grains is a relatively new phenomenon to our genome. There was always a small percentage of people that hadn't fully adapted to grains. They were the people who gained weight easily and/or suffered from a lot of food-related symptoms – certain populations more likely than others. Eastern Europeans, as well as Irish, had a greater preponderance to this sensitivity.

Then came 1996. That was the year that Monsanto received permission from the FDA (which is headed by an ex-Monsanto vice president, by the



way) to increase the percentage of gluten of our commonly consumed grains by 15%. Voila, mystery solved. So, for those of us who were perhaps under the radar, experiencing just minor irritation from this food variant, all of a sudden, minor became major.

To add insult to injury, your medical doctor will not be able to validate this for you if you suspect that it could apply to you. Medical doctors don't typically have any training in nutrition, so to look to food as a causative agent is not on their radar. Celiac disease is what they assume is the only possibility and celiac is not the same thing. Celiac disease is an autoimmune disorder triggered by wheat, but it presents with antibodies, and that's what your doctor will look for - not necessarily the same for a gluten intolerant person, although someone can be both.

So what to do? If you suspect that this may be you, it requires a 30-day, 100% elimination of all foods containing the above grains or gluten additives. I know that 100% is a big number, but it is necessary. In that first month, you are trying to make a determination about your response to

withdrawing from gluten intake. The bad news is that it only takes onetenth of one gram to get the inflammatory reaction going again. Imagine that you are a house on fire. The firefighter (you, eliminating gluten) is putting the fire out. The fire is going out nicely when someone puts in some kerosene. It doesn't take much kerosene to get the fire going full force again, does it? Well, that's how this allergic response works. You really have to go 100% for a full month to really know. If your symptoms also include mental or neurological problems, it make take up to three months to fully see how much of that is gluten. Dr. David Perlmutter, a neurologist with 35 years' experience, states in his book Grain Brain that, if you are gluten intolerant, you are 265% more likely to suffer from depression. Dyskinesia, a neurological disorder where people have uncontrolled movements from facial ticks to flailing limbs, have totally resolved with just this abstinence. I wouldn't have believed it either, except that I have a patient who experienced this exact phenomenon. I also recommend apps for your smart phones. "GF Living" and "GF Scanner" can help greatly to navigate these uncharted waters. There is more to this subject – feel free to delve further. I also recommend Dr. David Williams' book, Wheat Belly, and Dr. Robb Wolf's The Paleo Solution. These are great examples of what is possible. Along these lines, there is a great movie on Amazon Prime, The Perfect Human Diet, which can expand your understanding of the benefits of this effort.


