This is a reminder to all USA Dance professional and amateur members that the deadline to vote in the national elections is November 1. Ballots can be found in the September-October issue of *American Dancer* and extra ballots can be obtained from USA Dance's Central Office (800.447.9047). No copied or scanned ballots will be accepted.

I am supporting the incumbents, even though I don't agree with them on every issue. I feel that most of the challengers are unproven at a national level and need more national experience before I could support them.

One issue that I did not address in my editorial (because I did not realize that it would be on the ballot) is the issue of approving the new bylaws. The Governing Council has used its prerogative to change the bylaws in the past several years without membership approval. I am glad that they are asking the membership for their approval, but regret that I must vote against the changes. I agree with most of the revisions, but one significant change needs to be reconsidered, in my opinion. The structure of the Governing Council and the DanceSport Council have been changed to eliminate many elected positions to make them smaller - a good thing; however, seven of the 17 (GC) positions are now appointed by the new President upon taking office. This means that, with only one collaborator, the President can control most of the votes. A similar situation exists with the DanceSport Council. I suggest that, wherever practical, the positions be elected rather than appointed.

KADEL'S KORNER: QUICKSTEP When you finish running, try the Running Finish

The above headline is designed to get dancers to stop running, hopping and skipping around the dance floor, until more basic movements are properly mastered and accompanied by correct technique and the application of patterns that truly fit.

It is not pleasant to look at a couple drawing attention to themselves by flying down the floor when their general appearance is so poor. My good friend, Bill Davies, once remarked at a dance demonstration: "Why are they doing that?" Since then, I have often posed the same question: "Why are you doing that?"

Conversely, when these moves are performed by experienced dancers with good technique, they can greatly enhance the general atmosphere of their environment. You might appreciate the ease, attraction and usefulness of quickstep's Running Finish, which also brings you back to basics.

Back to basics means: Mind your footwork, amount of turn, dance position, rise and fall; watch your timing and general neatness; and dance a combination of patterns that are fun to do and pleasing to the eye.

You might want to consider using quickstep's Running Finish for its ease, attraction and usefulness. It consists of only four steps. The man starts on the inside of a right turn, the lady being on the outside of that turn. The man will start back on the left toe, while the lady will step forward on the heel, outside her partner's feet.

How to get there (since we don't have a GPS for dancers yet): the man should dance the best entries into the Running Finish. These are:

- A Progressive Chasse to the Right to back DW, into a Back Lock, Running Finish to face DC, or the LOD (or DW new LOD).
- Three steps of a Natural Turn to back the LOD, then a Back Lock and Running Finish to DC (or, if at a corner, DW new LOD). Now (if you ended DC or LOD) step back to dance another Running Finish to DW, or follow with a Quick Open Reverse.
- The Running Finish is the normal ending to the Running Right Turn.
- For advanced dancers: Having ended the Running Finish DC, turn the last step to the right to dance a Tipsy to the Left, or
- Quick Open Reverse, Hover Corte, Running Finish with no turn to DW.

The Running Finish timing: QQSS or SQQS - $1^{1\!\!/_{\!\!2}}$ measures.

MAN:

1. Left foot back. - Toe

2. Right foot to the side and slightly forward, between partner's feet. – Toe

3. Left foot forward, left side leading, preparing to step outside partner. – Toe Heel

4. Right foot forward, outside partner, facing towards wall. – Heel

The man should sway to the left on steps 2 and 3 of the Running Finish.

LADY:

- 1. Right foot forward, outside partner's feet. Heel Toe
- 2. Left foot to the side. Toe
- 3. Left foot back, left side leading. Toe Heel
- 4. Left foot back, facing partner. Toe

The lady should sway to the right on steps 2 and 3 of the Running Finish.

The amounts of turn to the right on the Running Finish can be: no turn, 1/8, 1/4, or 3/8; never 1/2 turn.

Consult your dance teacher for more details and options. Thank you and happy dancing!










NATIONAL DANCE COUNCIL OF AMERICA ELECTIONS - JANUARY 2014

By Vivian Beiswenger

The National Dance Council of America (NDCA) is the organization that regulates most professionally run dance competitions in the United States. Although it is running elections in January of 2014, no individual dancer, amateur or professional, will have the opportunity to vote in this election.

While professional dancers must register with the NCDA in order to participate in NDCA sanctioned events and amateurs may register, their registration fees do not give them a vote and they are not, in fact, considered members. The members of the NDCA are 16 dance organizations that are classified as full, affiliate and associate members. Each organization is assigned anywhere from 1 to 10 votes.

The full members, each having 10 votes, are:

Arthur Murray International Dance Teachers Club of Boston Dance Vision (DVIDA) Fred Astaire Dance of North America National Dance Teachers Association North American Dancesport Teachers Association Pan American Teachers of Dance US Imperial Society of Teachers of dancing US Terpsichore Association

The affiliate members are:

American Ballroom Company (1 vote) Brigham Young University (6 votes) Heritage Dance Foundation (1 vote) New York Society of Teachers of Dancing (2 votes) North American Dance Organizers Alliance (1 vote) Professional Dancers Federation (6 votes) World Federation of Ballroom Dance (1 vote)

Since the NDCA terminated USA Dance, Inc.'s associate membership over two years ago, there are no associate members and no direct amateur representation.

Only full member organizations can nominate candidates for office and only after the Nominating Committee has made its recommendations. The positions up for election are President and Second Vice President.

At the July 2013 meeting of the NDCA, the Nominating Committee selected the current President, Brian McDonald, as their candidate for President and Tom Murdock, who is currently Executive Secretary, for the position of Second Vice President. Two nominations from the floor were accepted: Sam Sodano, Organizer of the Ohio Star Ball Championships, for President and Daniel Messenger, organizer of the Wisconsin State Dancesport Championships, for Second Vice President - both recommendations from the North American Dance Teachers Association.

Dancers who have an interest in this election should contact their member organizations or work through their dance teachers, professional partners or competition organizers.
